The **SHENANIGANS TOURNAMENT** is a **singles** tournament based on singles games, scotch doubles games and trios games.

Your score will be based on 12 total qualifying games.

Four games are singles games. Four games are scotch doubles games. And four games are Baker Trios games. And you will rotate from trios, to scotch doubles to singles after each game. The singles games are self-explanatory. Your score counts towards your singles score.

During scotch doubles games, you will be assigned a random scotch doubles teammate.

And EACH SCOTCH DOUBLES GAME thereafter you will be assigned a new scotch doubles partner and a new pair of lanes. Your team games count for both of you. So if as a team you shoot 250, you both get a 250 towards your singles total. If you shoot 150, well, you get the point.

During Baker Trios, again, you will be randomly assigned teammates for EACH GAME and you will all share the final score. Odd are, your teammates will be different for each of these team and doubles games

The top 8 singles scores will advance to the most Jacked up finals ever. With 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> bowling one blind draw baker trios game. Winners advance to join the #2 seed for a blind draw scotch doubles match. The winners of the scotch doubles match then face off in a head to head elimination game to see who faces the #1 seed in the singles finals.

This tournament is meant to be fun and with a healthy prize fund and added money, could be one of the most unpredictable, and entertaining events to participate in. Scores should be close and there will be plenty of chances to bowl with a bunch of random people. Space is limited so entries need to be turned in quickly.

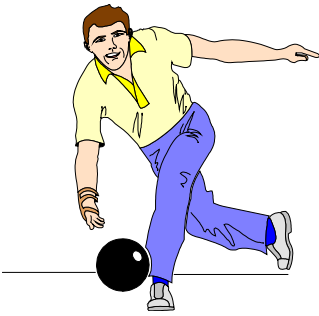

# Participation & Eligibility Rules

1. Must be a current member of the Alaska 700 Club to be eligible or pay **the \$25 Limited Membership fee** (see membership form for more information). Membership fees can be paid at the tournament site.
2. All bowling will be scratch.
3. Players eliminated in the same stepladder round will receive the same payout.
4. Scotch Doubles format: Bowlers on two-person teams will alternate shots. For example, Player 2 will convert Player 1's Spares and vice versa.
5. Baker Trios format: Bowlers on three person teams will alternate frames. Player 1 will bowl the 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 10<sup>th</sup> frames. Player 2 will bowl the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, & 8<sup>th</sup> frames and Player 3 will bowl the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> frames.
6. Players are responsible for maintaining their own scorecard/recap sheet. All scores should be initialed by a minimum of two players after each game.
7. As the payout progresses, last cash will always be equal to or better than the entry fee of \$100.

\*Limited Memberships are designed for players who would like to participate in 700 Club Satellite tournaments across the State, but do not have a valid 700 series. Any player who signs up for a limited membership is eligible to participate in all Alaska 700 Club satellite events **except the annual Alaska 700 Club Tournament**. However, if during the current calendar year season, **any player with a limited-membership that bowls a qualifying 700 series in league or tournament play, will be automatically upgraded to full membership status at no additional charge** and the subject player would then be eligible for the annual Alaska 700 Club Tournament. The player shall notify the Alaska 700 Club of the qualifying 700 series so it may be validated by the Club. Players need only pay the Limited Membership Fee ONCE PER SEASON! Additionally, players with a Limited Membership will not have a vote at the annual meeting.
